Subject: RECENT SENATE RESOLUTIONS ON ASSESSMENT REGULATIONS

We are pleased to inform all ODL students that Senate, during the recent assessment meetings made the following resolutions:

1. All Cohort 1 ODL students that were withdrawn on academic grounds should be allowed to repeat the failed courses.
2. All ODL students are now allowed to take courses in bundles comprising at least 50% of the total semester load, based on academic recommendations, in order to ease the pressure that comes with a large volume of workload. This in recognition of the fact that some ODL students have other commitments, and also in the spirit of flexible study.
3. An appropriate fee structure for each bundle shall be communicated soon.

Please note that due to consideration number 2 above, academic failure in future shall be treated as in the regulations. We therefore advise all students to consider taking bundles as you work towards writing exams for the current semester. If a student chooses to pend some courses by taking a certain bundle (few courses), the already paid fees shall be reserved to cater for the remaining courses in future.
